I am requesting that the Office of State and Tribal Programs of the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission participate in an advisory capacity to the Uravan Site Closure Committee. The Committee exists to close the Uravan site in a timely and efficient manner consistent with the Federal and State Consent Decree and applicable regulations by working together to achieve this common goal. The committee intends to reach this goal by:

1. Clearly understanding each organization's internal processes and needs for Uravan deletion, license termination, and land transfer.
2. Minimizing delays to deletion, termination, and land transfer process by identifying agency requirements for the Uravan site.
3. Providing a vehicle for ongoing discussions and clarification throughout the deletion, termination, and land transfer process.

Your staff's experience and knowledge regarding the above goals would greatly assist the committee and be appreciated.
