Approach for Other Alloy 600 Locations

- Determine what programs and guidance already exists from the Owners' Groups (BWOG, CEOG, WOG) and NSSS vendors for all other Alloy 600/82/182 locations.)
- Identify and evaluate the need for further work to develop appropriate disposition options for locations not already addressed in other programs.
- Work with Owner's Groups and NSSS vendors to create appropriate programs
 - List of work to be done by OGs and MRP (subject to resources being made available through the appropriate utility funding)
- Develop the appropriate level of guidance for items identified in the previous step.
