You are cordially invited to attend a public meeting between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and Nebraska Public Power District on April 8, 2003 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting will be conducted at the Brownville Concert Hall, Atlantic Avenue & 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Brownville, Nebraska. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the results of a recently completed integrated assessment of performance at Cooper Nuclear Station.

On February 6, 2003, the NRC completed an integrated assessment of performance at Cooper Nuclear Station. This integrated assessment included a review of performance indicators and the results of inspections conducted by the NRC. The assessment period was from January 1 through December 31, 2002.
