Dear Secretary,

Amounts of radioactive material that add incrementally allowed doses to the environment can integrate into amounts that exceed allowed doses. Radioactive material, from whatever source, is harmful to human health and should not be allowed in products used by people, or dispersed into the environment. In so far as is possible the by-products of nuclear fuel and nuclear weapons production should be carefully collected and stored at Government approved depositories.
