SUBJECT: PUBLIC MEETINGS OF MAY 13, 2003 (GORE HIGH SCHOOL) AND MAY 14, 2003 (SEQUOYAH FUELS CORPORATION FACILITY).

Dear Mr. Ellis:

On May 13, 2003, a public meeting was held in the cafeteria of the Gore High School to discuss clean up and reclamation of Sequoyah Fuels Corporation's (SFC's) former uranium conversion facility near Gore, Oklahoma. Enclosure 1 is a transcript from that meeting. Enclosure 2 is the attendance list from the meeting.

On May 14, 2003, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff conducted a public meeting and site visit at the SFC facility. At that meeting, SFC discussed the site and the reclamation plan, using maps and aerial photographs as aids. SFC requested, and received from NRC staff, clarification of some of the requests for additional information attached to NRC's letter of March 24, 2003. SFC then conducted a site tour for NRC staff and others in attendance.
