Application for Renewal of Operating Licenses

Gentlemen:

In a letter dated September 6, 2001, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Station, LLC (NMPNS) notified the NRC of its plans relating to the renewal of Operating Licenses DPR-63 and NPF-69 for Nine Mile Point (NMP) Units 1 and 2, respectively. That letter noted that an application for renewal of the NMP operating licenses was anticipated to be filed by the end of 2003.

As discussed in a telephone conference call with the NRC on April 14, 2003, NMPNS has decided to revise its submittal date for the license renewal application. Consistent with the guidance contained in Regulatory Issue Summary 2003-02, "Importance of Giving NRC Advance Notice of Intent to Pursue License Renewal," NMPNS hereby notifies the NRC of its intent to submit the application for renewal of the NMP operating licenses by May 31, 2004.
