In accordance with the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969, the Department of Energy has prepared an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the installation and operation of upgraded fire protection systems and related domestic water systems at the Savannah River Site. This project, which the Department expects to last at least 8 years, will make Savannah River Site fire detection and suppression systems consistent with current codes and practices. Based on the analysis presented in the EA, the Department has determined that this action does not require the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement.


The Assistant Secretary of Energy for Environment, Safety, and Health has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the Fire Protection EA. However, the Department has elected not to publish the FONSI for this proposed activity in the Federal Register because the project is not of national significance.

The Department of Energy is sending you this notice because of your past interest in Savannah River Site environmental issues and because the Department has a continuing interest in involving the public in NEPA activities.
