Hello,

I would like to comment on the pending regulation regarding 'recycling' of nuclear materials in consumer products. In matters such as these, I think it is best to use the "Precautionary Principle" -- if there is any doubt or uncertainty about the safety of a thing or a procedure, eschew all usage or implementation thereof until there is no doubt that it is safe!

In other words, please don't introduce radioactive materials into consumer products. There is simply no reason to subject human beings to even the possibility of higher radiation exposure.

Until we have strong studies using human subjects that speak to the effects of using radioactive material in consumer products, it is simply unjustifiably unsafe to do so. Computer models and simulations do not provide adequate proof. Please refrain.
