I live a few miles from Peach Bottom Reactor in Pa. and am always concerned about low level radioactivity released into the atmosphere and the long term effect that would have.

This country has an incomplete nuclear waste policy and to allow any radioactive material to be "recycled" would be a mistake and a compromise to an already faulty system.

In the light of the recent legislative initiative to fund new nuclear facilities, I hope the nrc will judge such expansion ill-advised when there is no fool-proof method to deal with nuclear waste.
