SUBJECT: SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION POTENTIALLY RELEVANT  
AND MATERIAL TO LICENSING BOARD PROCEEDING IN THE  
MATTER OF PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC CO. (Diablo Canyon  
Power Plant Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation)

In conformance with the Commission's policy on notification of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (ASLB) of new, relevant and material information, this memorandum provides the information discussed below.

The NRC staff has reviewed the Environmental Report submitted by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) on December 21, 2001, as part of PG&E's license application for an independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI) at the Diablo Canyon Power Plant. In the attached letter to Commissioner James D. Boyd of the California Energy Commission (CEC), from James R. Hall, dated June 24, 2003, the NRC staff transmitted its draft Environmental Assessment (EA) for the proposed action. Consistent with NRC policy for State consultations, the staff has offered the CEC, in its role as the designated State Liaison Office, the opportunity to provide comments on the draft EA prior to its issuance.

As the CEC is also an interested governmental participant in this case, the staff has determined that this information should also be brought to the attention of the ASLB and all parties, due to its relevance to the NRC staff's pending review of PG&E's application.
