AUDITING TRAINING COURSE

An auditing training course has been planned for Division of High-Level Waste Management (HLWM) technical staff who participate in audits and surveillances of the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Office of Civilian Radioactive Waste Management (OCRWM). Because of the increased emphasis on the participation of technical staff from outside the Quality Assurance discipline in these activities, it is important to enhance their familiarity with proper auditing approaches and techniques. A contract has been issued to Science Applications International Corporation to develop and teach the training course which will provide HLWM technical personnel with theory, techniques, and practical exercises to improve their understanding of accepted auditing practices for the nuclear industry and high-level waste repository program.

The training course will consist of three days of class instruction and a fourth day of course review and a written examination. The course will involve active participation and role playing in workshops and exercises by all class participants. After completion of the course and exam, participants will receive a certificate confirming attendance and course completion. The course content includes:
