

## SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT

### SUMMARY

By application dated June 11, 2003, NAC International (NAC) requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9203, for the Model No. NLI-10/24 package. NAC did not request any changes to the package design or authorized contents. The certificate has been renewed for a five year term.

### EVALUATION

By application dated June 11, 2003, NAC requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9023, for the Model No. NLI-10/24 package. NAC did not request any changes to the package design or authorized contents. The staff reviewed the documents referenced in the certificate and determined that the documentation was available and complete. The staff also reviewed the operating and maintenance procedures for the package and found them to be adequate.

Condition 3.(a) was revised to reflect NAC's current address.

Condition No. 5(c) of the certificate was revised to clarify that the Transport Index for criticality control is the same as the Criticality Safety Index as defined in the International Atomic Energy Agency Regulations for the Safe Transport of Radioactive Material (TS-R-1).

Condition 17. was added to clarify that fabrication of new packages or major packaging components, including the fuel basket, is not authorized.

### CONCLUSION

The certificate has been renewed for a five year term that expires on July 31, 2008. This change does not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
