Ref: Letter from R. Stein (DOE) to R. Browning (NRC) dated
March 17, 1988

The referenced letter provided the status of references associated with the Consultation Draft Site Characterization Plan (SCP/CD) for the Yucca Mountain site. This letter provides an update on the status of references.
