The Division of Waste Management (DWM) conducted a parallel effort to evaluate the short- and long-range goals of the ACS. Each of these activities has identified the need for increased coordination between the Office of Information Resources Management (IRM) and NMSS. Specifically, NMSS is considering changes to its document management strategy and the configuration of its high-performance computing environment. The first activity could be impacted by the development of ADAMS, and the second requires an assessment of current technology and its integration with AUTOS. These activities will be coordinated through the NMSS ACS Steering Board (ACS-SB). I am requesting that IRM designate liaisons to the ACS-SB to facilitate these efforts by November 1, 1997.
