Staff have reviewed the Draft Environmental Assessment Related to the Core Laboratories, Inc. Alternate Disposal Request to Inject Well-Logging Waste in Class II Disposal Wells. They concur with the proposed action to dispose of the materials into Class II disposal wells.

It should be noted that ProTechnics, a Division of Core Laboratories, LLP has a license (545-01) in Colorado to use several of the tracers, but not all of the tracers, discussed in the Draft Assessment. They are also licensed to use Gold 198 as a tracer, which is not included in Section 5.1 of the Draft. The amendment of the license should include a statement that the licensee should comply with reciprocity requirements and, if necessary, amend the State's license when operating in non-NRC licensed States.
