The purpose of this modification is to revise the Statement of Work to include a peer review of the study required under this subject task order, at no additional cost or obligation to the Government. Accordingly, the task order is hereby modified as follows:

The following paragraph is inserted to Section 3.2 of the Statement of Work:

"Upon incorporating NRC comments, the contractor shall conduct a "limited" peer review of the report in order to assess the adequacy and robustness of the findings. The contractor shall address the peer reviewer's comments and, when appropriate, shall incorporate changes into the final version of the report to be submitted to the NRC.

The estimated level of effort is 40 staff hours."

The issuance of this modification does not amend any other terms and conditions of the subject task order, including the ceiling amount of \$80,633.07.




