Dear Mr. Browning:

The Nuclear Waste Technical Review Board will meet in Atlanta July 23-26, 1990. The full Board will meet on Monday, July 23 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for a briefing by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission on the licensing support system that will be used to license the design, construction, and operation of a permanent repository for high-level nuclear waste. On July 24-25, the Board's Structural Geology & Geoengineering and the Hydrogeology & Geochemistry Panels will hold a two-day, joint meeting from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Discussion at this meeting will focus on the exploratory shaft facility and the surface-based testing program that are planned for the Yucca Mountain site. Both meetings are open to the public. The Board will meet in closed session the afternoon of July 23 and from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on July 26, 1990, to review the work of its panels to date and to discuss internal administrative and personnel matters.

All meetings will be held at the Westin Peachtree Plaza Hotel (Henry Grady Room), 210 Peachtree Street, Atlanta, Georgia 30303. A block of rooms has been reserved with a government rate of \$67 (plus tax). Individuals desiring to attend may make reservations by calling 1-800-228-3000 or (404) 659-1400.
