**PURPOSE:** 

On April 28-29, 1992, the NRC and DOE will conduct a technical exchange to discuss technical and regulatory issues related to the methods for developing and screening scenarios and the construction of a Complementary Cumulative Distribution Function (CCDF). The technical exchange will address the current operational definition of scenarios, how scenarios are to be generated from elemental processes and events, what initial set of processes and events should be considered, and appropriate methods for screening scenarios. The technical exchange will also address the use of a definition of scenarios that is consistent with the logic needed to construct a CCDF, and the use of expected partial performance measures to guide site characterization. Finally, the treatment of human intrusion will be discussed and whether it is appropriate to

treat human intrusion separately from the processes and events

that are included in a CCDF.
