Dear Mr. Kinneman:

I am writing regarding the NRC's proposed public input session scheduled for July 16, 2003.

I previously filed a petition on June 23, 2003 on behalf of numerous citizens of the area requesting an Evidentiary Hearing.

Accordingly, I object to the public input session, and request that it be cancelled, and make that on the following grounds:

- a. No notice was given to me;
- b. There has been no action on our Petition for a hearing on the record, and the public input session would have a confusing and potentially prejudicial effect on the need for an evidentiary hearing, and the success of such a hearing;
- c. I will be on vacation in a preplanned week long trip to Wyoming with my family on July 16, returning on July 22.

I am perplexed why the NRC would ignore the request for a evidentiary hearing on the record, while proceeding, apparently in response to that petition, with a non-noticed public input session.

If the NRC proceeds with the input session on July 16, I will not have any opportunity to present my evidentiary witnesses, I will not attend, and I certainly object to any possible substitution of this clearly inadequate event, to replace the evidentiary hearing which is required by law and due process.
