SUBJECT: NMSS COMPUTER INFORMATION SYSTEMS OF PUBLIC INTEREST

The Office of Administration (ADM) is currently beginning a special study of the way the NRC utilizes electronic bulletin boards, World Wide Web (WWW) pages, and Internet to make computerized data bases and other information available to the public. In April 1995, the Deputy Executive Director for Nuclear Materials Safety, Safeguards and Operations Support established an office-level working group to develop guidance for making NRC information accessible electronically to the public. Based on the working group's recommendations, interim guidance was prepared assigning ADM the responsibility for managing this program for the agency. The guidance will be revised as required and will eventually be incorporated into the NRC Management Directive system.

To assist ADM in this task, each NRC office is being asked to review its own computer-based information systems and databases carefully (including not only those large databases and systems that the Office of Information Resources Management has developed and/or administers for us, but also those databases and information compilations that we generate internally), and to provide ADM with a listing of those that we feel would be of sufficient interest to any or all of the groups listed below to be incorporated into plans for consistent and uniform usage of a WWW server.

- Applicants and Licensees
- Public Interest Groups (environmental, etc.)
- Students, Researchers and Educational Institutions
