Dear Mr. Stein:

During our management meeting on December 2, 1987, we discussed availability and distribution of consultation draft SCP copies and references. Subsequently, we telefaxed the enclosed mailing list to your staff. This letter is a follow-up to our discussions in that meeting to confirm the NRC staff needs with respect to this subject.

It was agreed that 40 copies of each of the three consultation draft SCPs would be delivered to the NRC staff and contractor locations by the DOE official issuance data (currently January 8, 1988). Furthermore, since the NRC ideally needs a total of 86 copies, you agreed to consider the possibility of sending the additional 46 copies. Enclosure 1 is the mailing list for both the NRC staff and contractors for both the original 40 copies and the additional 46 copies. Of the 19 copies for the January 8, 1988 delivery to me, 2 should be bound and 17 should be unbound and three-hole punched. Of the subsequent delivery to me, 15 should be bound and all the others unbound and three-hole punched. As discussed, we would appreciate that specific arrangements be made for the delivery to me at our new Rockville, Maryland address. It should be specified that this delivery be an inside delivery and that 24 hours before delivery the shipper should call the NRC operator (800-368-5642); ask for C. Fornaro (x28220) and provide him with the delivery time. Such notification will allow us to prepare for distribution of the unloaded copies to the staff. It would also be useful to identify a shipping contact for each project in the event delivery adjustments are necessary.

Also, based on our discussions in the December 2, 1987 management meeting, we understand that all the references for the three consultation draft SCPs will be delivered by January 8, 1988. For the Deaf Smith Co. site references, we agree with the DOE plan to only provide references which supplement the final EA collection that DOE has previously given to NRC. While we will accept references on January 8, 1988 in either hard copy or microfiche form, we would like to receive one hard copy and one microfiche copy of all references for each consultation draft SCP. In cases where references are received in one form only by January 8, 1988, we request that DOE provide the references in the remaining form as soon as possible. All references should be sent to me at the address given in Enclosure 1. Hardcopy deliveries should be handled in the same manner as the delivery of the consultation draft SCP copies described above.


