SUBJECT: TRANSMITTAL OF WAPPA-B TAPE TO NRC

The purpose of this letter is to confirm that A. Avel of SRPO has hand-delivered to R. Johnson of your staff on, April 25, 1986, a magnetic tape containing the WAPPA-B computer code which was used in the Waste Package Performance Assessment in the Draft Salt Repository Environmental Assessment Reports. This is an unverified, uncontrolled code.
