

SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT

SUMMARY

By application dated June 12, 2003, General Atomics (GA) requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9226, for the Model No. GA-4 package. GA did not request any changes to the package design or authorized contents. The certificate has been renewed for a five year term.

EVALUATION

By application dated June 12, 2003, GA requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9226, for the Model No. GA-4 package. GA did not request any changes to the package design or authorized contents. The staff reviewed the documents referenced in the certificate and determined that the documentation was available and complete. The staff also reviewed the operating and maintenance procedures for the package and found them to be adequate.

CONCLUSION

The certificate has been renewed for a five year term that expires on October 31, 2008. This change does not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.

Condition 3.a. was revised to reflect General Atomics current zipcode.

Condition 5.a.(3) the wording "Proprietary Version" was added to clarify that the approved design is proprietary.

Condition 5.c. was revised to clarify that the Transport Index for criticality control is the same as the Criticality Safety Index as defined in the International Atomic Energy Agency Regulations for the Safe Transport of Radioactive Material (TS-R-1).

The General Atomics application dated August 31, 1994, referenced in condition 3.b. was added to the reference section.

The August 5, 1998, Safety Analysis Report submittal, Revision G (Proprietary) and Revision H (Non-Proprietary), was changed to be referred to as a supplement rather than the original reference.
