Dear Mr. Meyer:

According to the notice filed in the August 19, 1987, issue of the Federal Register, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission has announced its intent to establish a local public document room at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas Library. We are indeed pleased that you are considering this location and I am writing you this official letter expressing our willingness to house, maintain, and provide public access to the collection.

The Special Collections department at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas Library is the only agency in southern Nevada endeavoring to create and maintain a comprehensive collection of materials pertaining to the growth and development of this area. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission records concerning the potential High-Level Waste Geologic Repository Site, Yucca Mountain, Nevada, would complement material already available in the collection. All of the materials located in our Special Collections department are available to anyone who has need of them. Because of the comprehensive nature of our Nevada collection, many researchers know of our Special Collections department and the library is used by many existing user groups.

Specifically, the library is willing and able to house, maintain and provide public access to the collection. Shelf-space is available and copying and micrographic equipment are nearby. Public parking is available, but public transportation in Las Vegas is minimal. Although our Special Collections department is not open during the evening, we would make special arrangements to provide needed material to users if they should require access to the collection during those hours. The department is open for service on Sunday afternoons.
