NEVADA NUCLEAR WASTE STORAGE INVESTIGATIONS (NNWSI) PROJECT WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS FOR THE WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 4, 1986.

I. Critical Items Status

Final revisions to Chapter 7 of the SCP were completed by Lawrence Livermore staff. The chapter is now undergoing final review before transmittal to Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC).

Waste Management Project Office (WMPO) comments were resolved by Los Alamos for three quality assurance level assignments and supporting documentation (Natural Isotope Chemistry; Tectonics and Volcanism — Volcanism and Tectonics; and Volcanism Surface Exposure by Rock Varnish Dating Techniques) submitted earlier. The revised submissions were sent to WMPO.

II. Significant Accomplishments/Information Items

SAND84-2621 report entitled "Final Report: G-Tunnel Small-Diameter Heater Experiments" was sent to the WMPO for policy review on August 19, satisfying Milestone N444.

Sandia Letter Report #SLTR86-003, "A Proposed Approach for Data Transfer and Management by the Nevada Nuclear Waste Storage Investigations (NNWSI) Project," was transmitted to WMPO on August 25. This letter report satisfies NNWSI Project Milestone R077, "Plans and Procedures for the Tuff Data Base Operations."

Sandia NNWSI Project personnel and representatives from major subcontractors attended a Nuclear Regulatory Commission licensing briefing presented by D. Vieth, M. Glora, J. VanVlieth, D. Swanson, and E. Hill on August 27 in Albuquerque.

Sandia report (SAND85-2701) entitled, "Preliminary Estimate of Ground-water Travel Time and Radionuclide Transport at the Yucca Mountain Repository Site," has been published.

Responses were prepared by Lawrence Livermore for three items requested by Headquarters to complete the revisions to the Draft Waste Acceptance Preliminary Specifications. The responses were telefaxed to Mike Valentine at WMPO on August 28.

An annotated outline for the Environmental Program Plan (EPP) has been completed by SAIC and sent to WMPO for review and comment.

Draft working papers for an Environmental Monitoring and Mitigation Plan were sent on August 29 to WMPO for transmittal to headquarters.

The briefing that was to be presented to the State of Nevada on Site Characterization activities was cancelled at the request of Headquarters.
