NEVADA NUCLEAR WASTE STORAGE INVESTIGATIONS (NNWSI) PROJECT WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS FOR THE WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 18, 1986.

I. Critical Items Status

Chapter 7 (Waste Package) of the Site Characterization Plan (SCP) was distributed to Permanent Internal Review Committee (PIRC) members on September 10. The comment resolution meeting will be held during the third week of October.

Three PIRC comment resolution meetings will be held next week as follows: PIRC 13 (Higher Level Findings), PIRC '12 (Performance Assessment), and PIRC 1 (Geology).

Revisions to SCP Chapter 6 (Sections 6.0, 6.1, and 6.2) are expected to be completed at Sandia by October 7.

Chapter 2 is being edited by PIRC 16 (editorial consistency review). The comment resolution meeting is being held September 16 through 18 in Las Vegas.

Draft scientific investigation planning documentation was sent to the Waste Management Project Office (WMPO) by Lawrence Livermore for the EQ3/6 task quality assurance level assignments.

A Core Library Steering Committee meeting was held this week to initiate work on a report of committee findings to WMPO. There is no projected completion date for the report at this time.

I-A. Project Manager's Concerns

II. Significant Accomplishments/Information Items

The Seismic/Tectonics Working Group is preparing for a dry-run on October 13-14 of their Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) proposed Appendix 7 meeting. The Project has suggested to headquarters that the NRC meeting be held the first week in November.

Wendy Dixon, Chief of the Systems & Project Control Branch, WMPO has begun a 90-day rotational assignment in Headquarters, Department of Energy (DOE). Wendy will be working directly with the Under Secretary (US) for the DOE, Joseph Salgado, and other members of his immediate staff until December 12, 1986. Wendy was selected, by Tom Clark, Manager, Nevada Operations Office, for this temporary assignment to broaden her knowledge and understanding of Headquarters operations and to provide her skills and expertise in the US's Office.

A meeting was held in Las Vegas on September 9 & 10, to discuss HQ's guidance to the projects for ACD Requirements documents. The meeting was attended by Charles Brooks (OGR-Systems), Nadia Dayen-Sheaks (Weston), Erik Svensan (Weston), R. Schlesser (RHO-BWIP), and representatives from all NNWSI Project participants. Discussions included; site specific requirements document format and content, subsystem design requirements document format and content, subsystem design requirements document format and content, subsystem structure to be used, checklist being developed by OGR and BWIP for site subsystem structure, problems with the manner in which the projects have integrated the issues resolution process with the systems engineering process, and NNWSI's position on the prerequisite requirements documents. The NNWSI Project will develop a table of contents for a consolidated requirements document that meets the impact William J. Purcell

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on Project cost and schedule. The use of the Physical Subsystem Structure as the organizing format for the SDR, Cost Estimates, etc., will be confirmed by HQ.
