SUBJECT: YUCCA MOUNTAIN SITE FIELD TRIP

The understanding of the influence of geology on waste isolation at the proposed HLW site is dependent upon field observations of geologic features (i.e., structures, rock types and variability, geomorphic characteristics, etc.). To aid in the understanding of the geology of the proposed HLW site I would like to propose a field trip by GT staff prior to SCP review. Participants representing the NRC should include: C. Abrams, K. McConnell, M. Blackford, B. Ibrahim, J. Trapp, J. Bradbury, P. Bembia, W. Ford, K. Stablein, L. McKague, and C. Purcell. The participation of State and NNWSI personnel is also anticipated.

The following is a list of geologic features and/or locations which are now or may become important topics with respect to siting a HLW repository at Yucca Mountain. Beside each geologic point of interest is listed the USGS, NRC, or State representatives suggested as important for descriptions and explanations.

Busted Butte - faults, calcite deposits, sand ramps, and Stage Coach fault at southern end.
