19 SEC. 301. Section 202 of the Energy Reorganization
20 Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C 5842) is amended by—

21 (1) inserting "(a)" after "SEC. 202."; and

22 (2) adding at the end thereof the following new
23 subsection:

24 "(b)(1) The Advisory Committee on Reactor Safe-
25 guards of the Commission (in this subsection referred to as

1 the committee) shall annually review and evaluate the im-
2 plementation of health and safety standards at Department
3 of Energy nuclear facilities, including research and other
4 kinds of reactor, waste storage facilities, reprocessing and
5 enrichment plants, special nuclear fuel depositories, and
6 defense facilities. Such review shall include a detailed ex-
7 amination of plant operations, a safety analysis, methodology
8 ~~and report~~ of all contractors, and actions taken to miti-
9 gate hazards. During its review, the committee shall exam-
10 ine selected facilities, including those related to weapons
11 development and other military applications of atomic
12 energy. The committee shall report to the Congress and
13 the Secretary of Energy on the results of its review and
14 evaluation on an annual basis.

15 “(2) Within one year after the receipt of the first
16 annual report issued by the committee pursuant to para-
17 graph (1), the Secretary of Energy shall, with respect to
18 each Department of Energy nuclear facility covered by the
19 report—

20 (A) close the nuclear facility;

21 (B) implement the recommendations of the
22 committee;

23 (C) release a draft environment impact state-
24 ment under the National Environmental Policy Act

1 of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.) on improvement at
2 the facility; or

3 (D) notify the committee and the Congress that
4 prompt implementation of the recommendations is
5 infeasible, and explain the reasons.

6 "(3) Notwithstanding any provision of law, the Secre-
7 tary of Energy shall fully cooperate with the committee in
8 its investigations and provide ready access to its facilities
9 and to information necessary to complete its review and
10 evaluation."
