Re: Questionnaire for Scenario Catalogue

As you recall from our meeting in March, the work on scenario identification and selection was given a high priority by PAAG. PAAG endorsed the proposal [PAAG/DOC(87)2] to review in depth the present knowledge and experiences and to discuss further a set of important issues on scenarios at an international level within NEA.

One important part of the background material for this work will be the collection of basic information with the help of a questionnaire as discussed at the PAAG meeting. Enclosed, you will find two copies of the scenario questionnaire. Please provide as complete answers as possible from your country by, if needed, distributing the questionnaire also to groups who have done performance assessments of nuclear waste repositories but who are not directly represented at PAAG.

I recognize that quite a substantial effort is needed to complete these questionnaires and I appreciate very much your co-operation in this matter. I am convinced that the results will be of great value for the further work on scenarios. The small working group on scenarios will be established in consultation with members of PAAG and partly on the basis of the answers received to the questionnaire. PAAG will regularly be kept informed of the progress in this matter and at the next PAAG meeting, it is planned to arrange a one-day topical discussion of scenarios.

Completed questionnaires should reach NEA before 1st of July 1987.
