YUCCA MOUNTAIN PROJECT WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS FOR THE WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 1, 1989

I. Critical Items Status

A. Site Characterization Plan (SCP) Progress Reports

Work is continuing on development of a plan for providing Yucca Mountain Project input to the semiannual progress reports.

Comment Response Summary

Work continued on final editing and cross-referencing of responses to comments made on the Consultation Draft of the SCP. The comment response package for Edison Electric Institute is essentially complete. Comment response packages for the State of Nevada and the U.S. Geological Survey are expected to be completed by mid-September.

SCP Study Plan Status: September 1, 1989

Study Plans 8.3.1.2.2.7, "Hydrochemical Characterization of the Unsaturated Zone," 8.3.1.2.3.1.7, "Reactive Tracers: C-Well Complex," and 8.3.1.15.1.3, "Laboratory Determination of Mechanical Properties of Intact Rock," are currently in post-revision audit status. Minor inconsistencies with comment dispositions are being corrected in the final drafts. These study plans will be submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) following successful completion of the audit.

Preparations are underway for accelerated comment resolution on Study Plan 8.3.1.8.1.1, "Probability of a Volcanic Eruption Penetrating the Repository." Some delays in reviews of the study plans are occurring due to unavailable resources.

Additional documentation in support of the Study Plan Assessment is being prepared. Preparation of study plan records packages is also in progress.

Formal identification of Principal Investigators for activities has been requested to formalize interfaces. Study plan and Sample Management Facility (SMF) staff are cooperating in this survey for mutual interface purposes.

B. Core Sample Management

Staff continued processing Utah Prototype borehole samples at the SMF.

A tour of the SMF was given to a reporter from the Dallas Morning News and to a legislative aid of Congresswoman Barbara Vucanovich.

C. Quality Assurance (QA)

A meeting was held to discuss alternate strategies for enhancement of the Exploratory Shaft Facility (ESF) design. QA staff participated on a subcommittee concerned with design changes.

The Yucca Mountain Project Office Software Quality Assurance Plan is being redrafted to incorporate comment resolutions. Implementing quality management procedures will be completed in September.

D. Exploratory Shaft Facility (ESF)

Alternate strategies were developed for the ESF design.

Staff completed input to and the review of a draft report on the advantages and disadvantages of qualifying all applicable data now rather than delaying this activity.

The Prototype Demonstration Excavation Feasibility Report has been submitted to editing. Concurrence has been received on the majority of the review comments.

A comment resolution meeting for management review of General Arrangement drawings by Holmes & Narver was held this week.

An overview of the container materials/corrosion program was presented to the Technical Review Board.

E. Long Range Planning and Project Planning and Control System (PACS)

Resource estimating of long range plan (LRP) network activities continued with a special training session being conducted for Lawrence Livermore National Laboratories on August 29, 1989.

Trial data has been entered into the PACS and preliminary output results are as expected. Plans for extending the LRP effort are underway, including planning for data entry.

F. Environmental Permitting

Work continues on the Desert Tortoise Biological Assessment (BA). The BA is scheduled for completion by the end of September.

II. Significant Accomplishments/Information Items

The fourth prototype drilling location west of Milford, Utah, has been abandoned because of unstable drilling conditions. A search has been initiated for another suitable location for resumption of the prototype dry drilling program. Drilling is anticipated to be restarted by mid-September.

Preparations continued for the opening of the Clark County Yucca Mountain Information Office. Activities include finalizing the draft text for the office exhibits and getting the exhibits reviewed and approved.

Production of the Review Record Memorandum (RRM) for the Technical Assessment Review (TAR) on the "resistivity anomaly" continued. Reference verification on a draft of the RRM text was completed. Final TAR recommendations are complete and the document is being readied for production and distribution.
