YUCCA MOUNTAIN PROJECT WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS FOR THE WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 15, 1989

I. Critical Items Status

A. Site Characterization Plan (SCP) Progress Reports

The Yucca Mountain Project participants initiated efforts to prepare their input to the project biannual status report and the second semiannual progress report.

Comment Response Summary

Work continued on final editing and cross-referencing of responses to comments made on the Consultation Draft of the SCP. Comment response packages for the State of Nevada and the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) are expected to be completed by the end of September.

B. Core Sample Management

Staff continued processing Utah prototype borehole samples at the Sample Management Facility.

C. Quality Assurance (QA)

A number of issues were discussed last week at the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE)/U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) meeting held in Washington, D.C. Among the issues discussed were the progress and content of Administrative Procedures (AP)-6.17Q and AP-5.28Q (grading packages), both of which focus on the preparation of the Q-list, Quality Activities List, and Grading (NUREG 1318). Edison Electric Institute (EEI) indicated they agreed with the grading packages approach because it will encourage consistency.

DOE will provide a copy of AP-5.9Q to the NRC and the State of Nevada and a copy of the policy paper on qualification of existing data for Title II once it has been completed.

The USGS Quality Assurance program was discussed. The NRC proposed to conduct a potential audit approximately three months after start work to assess the adequacy of implementation. EEI stated that a distinction should be made between acceptance of the program vs. acceptance of program implementation. The NRC accepts the program but remains hesitant until program implementation is more adequately demonstrated.

The 18-criteria audit of Sandia National Laboratories (SNL) was completed this week.

D. Exploratory Shaft Facility

The Prototype Demonstration Excavation Feasibility Report was finalized and transmitted to project management.

The revised Waste Package Program Plan annotated outline was completed and submitted to project management.

E. Long Range Planning (LRP) and Project Planning and Control System (PACS)

Resource estimating of LRP network activities continues with special training sessions being conducted as needed for participants.

Sessions are scheduled next week for Los Alamos National Laboratory and SNL. Participants have begun submitting PACS summary account input.

Programming for APECS 8000 screen and menu formats is ongoing.

F. Environmental Permitting

Work continues on the Desert Tortoise Biological Assessment (BA). The BA is scheduled for completion by the end of September.

G. <u>Nuclear Waste Technical Review Board (NWTRB) Meetings and</u> Interactions

The full Board met on September 13, 1989. The Board formally accepted the reports (including recommendations) of the following NWTRB Panels:

Structural Geology and Geoengineering Transportation and Containers Risk and Performance Assessment

On September 14, 1989, the Yucca Mountain Project Office made presentations to the Environmental and Public Health Panel on the environmental programs. Presentations on 40 CFR 191 were made to the Panel by DOE/Headquarters (HQ), the NRC, and the Environmental Protection Agency.

II. Significant Accomplishments/Information Items

Project staff worked with Holmes & Narver, Inc. graphics staff to review the final corrections of the paste-up of the Yucca Mountain brochure copy.
