SUBJECT: OGC ASSISTANCE REGARDING YUCCA MOUNTAIN QA ACTIVITIES

Following up on your discussion with John Gilray in Rockville on October 27, 1988, we have put together a proposed agenda for you regarding further discussions between us on the subject matter.

1. Meet with NRC site representative in Las Vegas to discuss the current status of NRC, DOE and State of Nevada QA Activities (discussion to focus on current and potential problem areas for QA).
2. Discuss recent results of observations and QA audits of DOE/YMPO contractors' activities. (This will familiarize you with our audit procedures and allow you an opportunity to suggest changes or improvements).
3. Visit DOE Nevada Test Site and the Yucca Mountain Site. (This will allow you to familiarize yourself with the site and will enable us to visually focus your attention on specific QA problem areas).

Please advise us of your travel plans as soon as possible as we need ten working days to arrange for the test site badging. We need to know exactly who is coming; please return the attached badging information for each individual.
