AND MATERIAL TO BOARD PROCEEDING IN THE MATTER  
OF THE U.S. ARMY AND THE JEFFERSON PROVING  
GROUND SITE

In conformance with the Commission's policy on notification of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (ASLB) of new, relevant, and material information, this memorandum provides the information discussed below.

On July 28, 2003, the U.S. Army (the licensee) verbally requested that the August 4, 2003 date for submission of its license amendment for the Jefferson Proving Ground (JPG) site be extended until the week of September 15, 2003. The Army states that a Range Study conducted by the Army Environmental Center and used extensively in the revision of the Environmental Monitoring Plan has not yet been made final. The Range Study will be complete and ready for release by the end of August. The NRC staff understands the need to use public documents in the submission of a license amendment and has granted the extension.

This information is being brought to the attention of the ASLB and all parties, as it may be relevant and material to issues pending before the ASLB.
