A vulnerability assessment of the Nuclear Waste Fund managed by DOE/NV was completed in September. The overall rating was established as low vulnerability to waste, fraud, and abuse.

HQ has notified the NNWSI Project that enough difference in the proposed WBS exists among the Projects to justify a meeting to discuss and resolve the differences. A tentative meeting has been called on Tuesday, October 16.

WMPO staff members met with Main-Hurdman auditors to explain the NNWSI Project so they will be able to understand how to conduct their audits effectively. The field offices have not yet received formal documentation from HQ as to the role these people play. This information needs to be passed on to the project participants so they can understand why outside auditors are involved.
