Subject: Confirmatory Action Letter No. 1-03-003			
<p>Summary:</p> <p>Mr. Vanaskie called to say they were holding a management meeting to discuss the CAL and they were unsure how to respond to Action No. 1 which requires, in part, an audit of all prostate seed implants performed at the institution prior to 2001 by the Radiation Oncology staff members who were involved in the four medical events reported thus far. Mr. Vanaskie said that the Radiation Oncology staff members were not the same from one treatment to the next and that only the Radiation Oncologist participated in all four of the therapies. I spoke with Pam Henderson, called Mr. Vanaskie back, and told him Pam intended to issue a revision to the CAL specifying that an audit be performed of all prostate seed implant cases performed prior to 2001 which involved this Radiation Oncologist. Mr. Vanaskie said this concerned him because the Radiation Oncologist was involved in all of the cases since 1995 and, while he had no numbers in front of him, they could be looking at auditing several hundred cases.</p> <p>I told Mr. Vanaskie a CAL was something that was negotiated between NRC and the licensee and that NRC would get agreement from the licensee prior to issuing the CAL. I told him that Pam would call him when she returned.</p>
