DAVIS-BESSE HEARING


Bob Tedesco called me on January 26th to indicate that the Davis-Besse Board had requested written answers to two questions which had previously been directed to their staff by means of an interrogatory. I understand that we had declined to answer these questions previously on grounds they were not relevant to the proceeding, however, the Board has now directed that these questions be answered in writing and the answers provided to the Board and parties early next week.

The questions that are following:

1. How long has SAC been using the area around the Big Rock point reactor in Michigan for making simulated test runs in unarmed B-52's? 7 years
2. What assurance do we have that the area around the proposed Davis-Besse plant will not be used in the future for purposes similar to those described in question 1 above?

As of now the Board has not decided whether this information will be regarded as testimony or not. Such a test will probably be made after the Board has reviewed the requested information.

As you can appreciate the spectra of answers to these questions is very long. If possible I would like to meet with you and OGC to discuss the extent of our proposed answers as soon as possible. I would like to have the responses prepared for Bob Tedesco if he comes home this weekend.
