
Dear Mr. Brochman,

As discussed in our phone call this morning, we will proceed with the Pathfinder Fuel Shipments on or about 15 July 2003. There are 417 elements that will be shipped in 9 different shipments, the first 8 containing 48 elements each. These are un-irradiated elements and will be Category III shipments. Framatome ANP has modified a WE-1 shipping cask with a Pathfinder insert and has obtained a Certificate of Compliance.

The shipments will be from Penn State University directly to Sandia National Labs. DOE Oak Ridge will be the shipper of record. They are coordinating with DOE Albq. for the legal requirements.
