During the recent Radioactive Waste Management Committee (RWMC) meeting held on June 6-7, 1991, at the OECD/NEA Headquarters in Paris, France, it was requested that all participating nations submit radioactive waste management program status report updates in accordance with the agreed upon outline established in April 1988. The outline was established as a result of a U.S. proposal in June 1987 for the NEA to coordinate a compilation of status reports describing the national high-level radioactive waste management programs, including information on administrative and regulatory aspects of these programs.

Attached is a copy of the U.S. radioactive waste management program's status report that was generated in September 1988 in accordance with the OECD/NEA outline established in April 1988. To comply with the recent OECD/NEA RWMC request described above, it is requested that you review and update those portions of the report which focus on your program, and subsequently return your modified report to me by COB August 30, 1991.
