Dear Mr. Gertz:

On November 29, 1989 this office transmitted a written request to the U.S. Geological Survey (R. Loux to R. Luckey) for three sets of hydrologic data for Yucca Mountain. The data requested were:

- 1) A listing of errors in transducer readings of static groundwater levels at Yucca Mountain.
- 2) A corrected set of transducer data; and
- 3) All groundwater - level monitoring data collected after January 1987.

On December 19, 1988, you transmitted to me a letter from the USGS (L. Hayes) which asserted that the data requested would be available in February 1989. This office has yet to receive the requested data.

I am aware that the U.S. Geological Survey has been under a stop-work order imposed by your office for Quality Assurance problems. The stop-work order may be the reason the State has not received the data requested. However, I understand that you have recently lifted that stop-work order. If this is the case, I would like to be informed as to when this Office might receive the data requested.


