Dear Mr. Johnson:

In response to your letter of February 3, 1984 to Catherine Russell, we have enclosed the correspondence and reports you requested from our October 1983 printouts. We have also included copies of all correspondence from our NNWSI correspondence files since October 1983. There are four documents you requested on the report listing which could not be reproduced; they are identified in Enclosure 2. We suggest you contact the source organizations for these reports.

Each of the record collections maintained by the Division of Waste Management Docket Control Center are, of course, voluminous; and the rate of increase is growing rapidly. In order to assure that you receive those documents of interest, we have outlined the types of documents available in Enclosure 3. Each of these document collections are logged on a word processor, and listings are available. The printouts we sent you earlier were listings of documents from our NNWSI correspondence file (Project WM-11) and NNWSI report collection.

In the area of published reports, we are on automatic distribution for documents from several different organizations, i.e., Rockwell, USGS, Battelle/ONWI, etc., and would suggest that you pursue contacting these organizations for published reports. Many of the reports, especially USGS reports, contain pull-out maps and charts which do not reproduce well. We have added your name to automatic distribution of NRC's formally published waste management contractor reports, NUREG/CR's.

In connection with our recent telephone conversation, I have enclosed the recently published Part 60 proposed rule on the unsaturated zone (49FR5934, dated 2/16/84) and NUREG-1046 referenced in this proposed rule. As discussed, the USGS Circular 903, also referenced, can be obtained free of charge by contacting the Distribution Branch, Text Products Section, USGS, 604 S. Pickett Street, Alexandria, VA 22304. Also enclosed are a copy of the USGS letter dated 2/1/84 on the siting guidelines and a copy of NRC's regulations 10 CFR Part 71, Packaging and Transportation of Radioactive Material.
