SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PUBLIC SCOPING MEETING TO DISCUSS UPDATE
TO THE GENERIC ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT FOR
LICENSE RENEWAL OF NUCLEAR PLANTS (NUREG-1437) AND
COMPANION RULE CHANGE

An environmental scoping meeting was conducted to discuss the first 10-year update to the Generic Environmental Impact Statement for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants (GEIS), NUREG-1437, and the rule change that would accompany the GEIS Update. The public meeting and its preceding informal open house were conducted in the evening on Tuesday, July 8, 2003, at the Doubletree Guest Suites in Atlanta, Georgia. Approximately 15 members of the public attended the meeting in addition to representatives of the NRC staff and NRC contractors from Pacific Northwest National Laboratory. Approximately six individuals spoke at the meeting; some of these individuals expressed concerns with the aging of nuclear power plants, how environmental justice was addressed in NUREG-1437, transportation of spent fuel, cancer rates in the vicinity of nuclear power plants, and the long-term storage of spent fuel in Yucca Mountain. Enclosure 1 contains the official corrected transcript for the meeting. Enclosures 2 and 3 are attachments to the transcript. Enclosure 2 is a comment submitted by Mary Olson of NIRS. Enclosure 3 is a report submitted by Rita Kilpatrick of Southern Alliance for Clean Energy. Enclosure 4 is a copy of the overhead slides used in the NRC's presentation.
