SENATE BILL No. 55—COMMITTEE ON HUMAN RESOURCES AND FACILITIES

JANUARY 29, 1985

Referred to Committee on Human Resources and Facilities

SUMMARY—Establishes legislative committee on high-level radioactive waste. (BDR 40-181)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: No.

EXPLANATION—Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to high-level radioactive waste; establishing the legislative committee on high-level radioactive waste; prescribing its powers and duties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 459 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
- 2 thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 3 1. *There is hereby created a committee on high-level radioactive*
- 4 *waste. It is a committee of the legislature composed of:*
- 5 (a) *Three members of the senate, appointed by the majority leader of*
- 6 *the senate.*
- 7 (b) *Four members of the assembly, appointed by the speaker.*
- 8 2. *The legislative commission shall select a chairman and a vice*
- 9 *chairman from the members of the committee.*
- 10 3. *The committee shall meet at the call of the chairman to study and*
- 11 *evaluate:*
- 12 (a) *Information and policies regarding the location in this state of a*
- 13 *facility for the disposal of high-level radioactive waste;*
- 14 (b) *Any potentially adverse effects from the construction and oper-*
- 15 *ation of a facility and the ways of mitigating those effects; and*
