NEVADA NUCLEAR WASTE STORAGE INVESTIGATIONS (NNWSI) PROJECT WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS FOR THE WEEK ENDING AUGUST 21, 1986

I. Project Manager's Concerns

In a letter to Alexander dated August 18, a sample study plan was transmitted, soliciting comments by September 8. (86-2095).

In a letter to Knight dated August 6, the Project requested comments by August 27 on proposed technical and Appendix 7 meetings with Nuclear Regulatory Commission and a proposed schedule. (86-2019)

II. Significant Accomplishments/Information Items

The scientific investigation planning documentation has been submitted to the Waste Management Project Office (WMPO) for the Lawrence Livermore Waste Package Assessment activities.

The Site Characterization Plan (SCP) Permanent Internal Review Committee (PIRC) 6 held a comment resolution meeting on August 11-13 to resolve comments on Sections 6.0 through 6.2 of Chapter 6. Corresponding markup of the text will be completed and sent to Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC) by August 22. Copies of the remainder of material to be reviewed by PIRC 6 (Sections 6.3 and 6.4 and design issues from Section 8.3) have been distributed to PIRC 6 members. Review comments will be resolved during an August 25-29 meeting.

The Sandia Quality Assurance Level Assignment (QALA) packages for Work Breakdown Structure (WBS) elements 1.2.1.3.1, 1.2.1.3.2, 1.2.1.3.3, 1.2.1.3.4, 1.2.4.2.1.3, 1.2.1.2.1, 1.2.1.2.2, 1.2.1.2.3, 1.2.1.2.4, 1.2.4.6.3, and 1.2.4.5 were approved by WMPO on August 8, 1986. This makes a total of 26 Sandia WBS elements that now have approved QALAs.

The request for proposals (RFP) for a technical management and support services contractor will be issued to the public on August 29. The preproposal conference will be conducted on September 22 and proposals will be due at DOE/NV on November 3.

Mitch Kunich and Don Schueler escorted members of U.S. Senator Chic Hecht's Staff on a helicopter tour consisting of an aerial view of Yucca Mountain, and a visit to the E-MAD facility, Control Point, and Climax.

A presentation was given by Mitch Kunich to the Consulting Engineers' Council of Nevada on August 20. About 20 engineers attended and the talk was well received.
