NEVADA NUCLEAR WASTE STORAGE INVESTIGATIONS (NNVSI) PROJECT WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS FOR THE WEEK ENDING JANUARY 22, 1988

I. Critical Items Status

A. Site Characterization Plan (SCP)

Planning and preparations for the SCP Consultation Draft (SCP/CD), plenary session and workshop sessions, to be held between the NNWSI Project, U.S. Department of Energy/Headquarters (DOE/HQ), and the State of Nevada, continued this week. These sessions have been scheduled as requested by the state. A dry run session will be held on January 26, in Reno, Nevada, and the plenary session on January 28-29, in Reno, Nevada.

Work continued on the Index for the SCP/CD. It is presently anticipated that a draft copy of the Index will be distributed to the state and Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on February 4, 1988.

Work continued on the Reviewer's Guide to the SCP/CD. It is presently anticipated that a draft copy of the Reviewer's Guide will be distributed to the state and NRC on February 4, 1988.

B. Core Sample Management

II. Significant Accomplishments/Information Items

Field activities have resumed at the Nevada Test Site (NTS). Prototype testing in the G-Tunnel will resume January 27, 1988.

Representatives from the U.S. Geological Survey, Science Applications International Corporation, Los Alamos National Laboratory, Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, Fenix & Scisson, and Holmes & Narver attended the Exploratory Shaft Facility (ESF) Seismic Design Basis Parameters Working Group meeting on January 18-19, in Las Vegas, Nevada.

A seismic design basis for the exploratory shaft was developed and a draft of this report is tentatively scheduled for delivery to the Interface Control Working Group on February 26.

The NNVSI Project Manager's Progress Report (Major Systems Acquisition Report) representing the status through the end of December 1987 was completed and submitted to DOE/HQ.

The monthly meeting of the Project Manager and Technical Project Officers (TPO) was held on Wednesday, January 20.

The first meeting of the Technical Data Advisory Group was held in Las Vegas, Nevada on January 19, 1988. The discussions mainly dealt with providing the ESF specific meteorological data for input to the Reference Information Base.
