2. Continuing need for seismo-tectonic workshop to discuss technical concerns in detail. The Sept. 22 & 23, 1987 meeting did not meet this need (Sept. 87 report).
3. That there be an NRC observer at all NNWSI audits of major participants (SAIC, SNL, LANL, USGS & F&S) (Aug. 87 report).
4. Hold appendix 7 visits with each technical discipline at least every 6 months (Aug. 87 report).
5. A QA appendix 7 visit to discuss the problems that arose from the NRC audit of LANL (June, 87 report).
6. A QA appendix 7 visit to discuss the rationale behind QA level assignments (Mar. 87 report).
7. Comment and resolution with DOE on the DOE definition of the following:

  - Unanticipated process and events
  - Engineered barrier system
  - Substantially complete containmentPlus -
  - Underground facility
  - Disturbed zone
  - Site
  - Restricted area
  - Accessible environment
