YUCCA MOUNTAIN PROJECT WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS FOR THE WEEK ENDING FEBRUARY 24, 1989

I. Critical Items Status

A. Site Characterization Plan (SCP)

Work continued on preparation of a summary of U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) responses to comments made on the Consultation Draft of the SCP by the State of Nevada, Edison Electric Institute, and the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS)/Reston. Draft responses have been prepared for approximately 95 percent of the comments in preparation for an Integration Group meeting on March 1-3, 1989.

A pre-meeting was held with DOE/Headquarters (HQ) on February 22, 1989, to prepare for an upcoming meeting with the Advisory Committee on Nuclear Waste (ACNW). The actual ACNW presentation was held on February 23, 1989.

SCP Study Plan Status: February 24, 1989

The five Exploratory Shaft Facility (ESF) construction phase related Study Plans have been approved and are being issued through the controlled distribution system. A preliminary draft of the DOE's assessment of the process used to develop these Study Plans was completed and submitted for a Quality Management Procedure 06-03 review.

The revised version of the Midway Valley Trenching Study Flan, 8.3.1.17.4.2, "Evaluating the Location and Recency of Faulting Near Prospective Surface Facilities," was received on February 18, 1989, and is in a project audit review. Efforts are underway to incorporate the graded quality assurance provisions into this Study Plan.

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B. Core Sample Management

A tour of the Sample Management Facility was given to Jennifer Warren, a reporter from the Los Angeles Times newspaper.

C. Quality Assurance

The Audit Team Leader Handbook was completed on February 16, 1989, and issued for use on upcoming Gold Star audits. The handbook provides a standardized methodology for conducting Yucca Mountain Project Office audits.

The use of Scientific Investigation Plans (SIPs) was discussed at a meeting between Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC) and DOE. During the meeting, it was indicated that Study Plans will replace SIPs for site characterization activities.

D. Exploratory Shaft Facility (ESF)

Staff met with the Bureau of Mines and DOE to discuss the ESF dust abatement requirements.

Efforts continued to develop a methodology to implement requirements specified in NUREG-1318. The impact of these requirements is being investigated.

E. Long Range Planning (LRP)

Revisions to the LRP Work Breakdown Structure (WBS) Dictionary were completed. Draft copies were forwarded to the Work Authorization System (WAS) Development Team to be used as guidance on the WAS for fiscal year 1991. The "Objective" statements in the dictionary, at the lowest level WBS element, will be used as the descriptive statement in the budget outlay explanation section of the WAS.

The LRP Support Team is scheduled to begin the final review of the individual WBS networks in a workshop starting on February 27, 1989. At the conclusion of this review, the Working Integration Teams will begin the process of integrating all of the networks into a single data base.

II. Significant Accomplishments/Information Items

The Office of Institutional and External Affairs, SAIC, finalized a technical paper on the project to be presented by Carl P. Gertz, Project Manager, at the Waste Management '89 Conference in Tucson, Arizona, on February 27, 1989.

Yucca Mountain Project Update meetings were continued on February 21, 1989, and February 23, 1989, in Caliente and Reno, Nevada, respectively. Both were well attended and successful in their attempts to inform attendees of the DOE's activities in Nevada and the site characterization process. Presentation topics included the SCP, transportation/emergency response, and the potential impact that the repository could have on communities.

I. Critical Items Status

A. Site Characterization Plan (SCP)

Work continued on preparation of a summary of U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) responses to comments made by the State of Nevada, Edison Electric Institute, and the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS)/Reston. Individual responses were collected and development of a partial comment response draft package was initiated.

SCP Study Plan Status: February 10, 1989

The fifth Exploratory Shaft Facility (ESF) construction phase related Study Plan was submitted to DOE/Headquarters (HQ) for final concurrence prior to controlled distribution. Upon approval, the Study Plan will be formally transmitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC).

A joint HQ/Yucca Mountain Project Office (Project Office) comment resolution meeting for Study Plan 8.3.1.2.2.3, "Characterization of Yucca Mountain Unsaturated-Zone Percolation - Surface-based Studies," was held this week. Meetings are scheduled to resume on February 13, 1989.

A review of the preparation, review, and approval process for the five ESF Study Plans was initiated. Upon completion, a final report will be forwarded to DOE/HQ and the NRC.

The comment resolution process for the Integrated Data System Technical Assessment Review was completed this week.

E. Long Range Planning (LRP)

The Work Authorization System (WAS) Review Team completed its review of Project Office guidance for preparation of the fiscal year (FY) 91 WAS. The guidance package was sent to participant organizations and members of the WAS Development Team.

Revisions to the LRP Work Breakdown Structure (WBS) Dictionary continued in small workshops this week. All revisions have now been completed, and the dictionary is being readied for review by the participant Technical Project Officers prior to Project Office review and approval.
