SUBJECT: DISCUSSION WITH EDISON ELECTRIC INSTITUTE (EEI)

On Friday, June 8, 1989, I had an approximate one hour discussion with Christopher Henkel of Edison Electric Institute and Michael Schwartz of Energy Resources International, Inc., regarding the present perspective and status of the YMP-QA program. The specific topics discussed were the recent QA reorganization, the QA classification and grading of items and activities and the development of QA software controls. In summary there was general agreement that changes in the QA organization appeared to be a significant improvement in the management of the QAP and in the utilization of QA talents within MAC and SAIC relative to the development, implementation and auditing of the QAP.
