**GEORGIANS AGAINST NUCLEAR ENERGY'S  
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SURREPLY  
TO DCS'S REPLY TO GANE'S OPPOSITION TO  
DCS'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY DISPOSITION  
OF CONSOLIDATED CONTENTION 11**

Georgians Against Nuclear Energy ("GANE") hereby requests leave from the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("ASLB") to file a surreply to DCS's Reply to GANE's Opposition to Motion for Summary Disposition of Consolidated Contention 11 (hereinafter "DCS's Reply"). In its surreply, GANE seeks to respond to DCS's assertion that GANE's criticisms of Table 4.11 of the draft Environmental Impact Statement ("EIS") for the proposed MOX Facility are outside the scope of Contention 11 because GANE has not amended Contention 11 to address deficiencies in the draft EIS. DCS's Reply at 4. As confirmed in paragraph 6 of the Affidavit of David Brown, submitted by the NRC Staff in support of its response to DCS's summary disposition motion, the data

on solid TRU waste in Table 4.11 of the draft EIS is based on information provided in DCS's Environmental Report ("ER"). While there are differences between Table 3-3 of the ER and Table 4.11 of the draft EIS with respect to the manner of presentation of information, including units of measure and categorization of information, these differences are not, in GANE's view, significant enough to have warranted amendment of Contention 11 when Table 4.11 was published.<sup>1</sup> GANE seeks an opportunity to discuss the factual and legal bases for its position in a surreply.

Counsel for GANE has consulted counsel for DCS, who stated that DCS intends to oppose this motion. Counsel for GANE was unable to reach counsel for the NRC Staff.
