Dear Mr. Copeland:

Enclosed, as requested, is a copy of a topographic map of Yucca Mountain and vicinity, Nevada, showing the locations of trenches. This map was prepared for NRC's use in preparation for the USGS Geologic Division data review scheduled for late September.

Two trenches on the Rock Valley fault are not in the area of the map. These trenches are about 23 miles southeast of Yucca Mountain. During 1984 these two trenches have been logged and studied in considerable detail relative to the more preliminary work on the trenches that are located on the enclosed map.

When you decide which trenches you wish to examine please inform me so that the Geological Survey can expedite any desirable cleaning or other preparation, of the trenches.

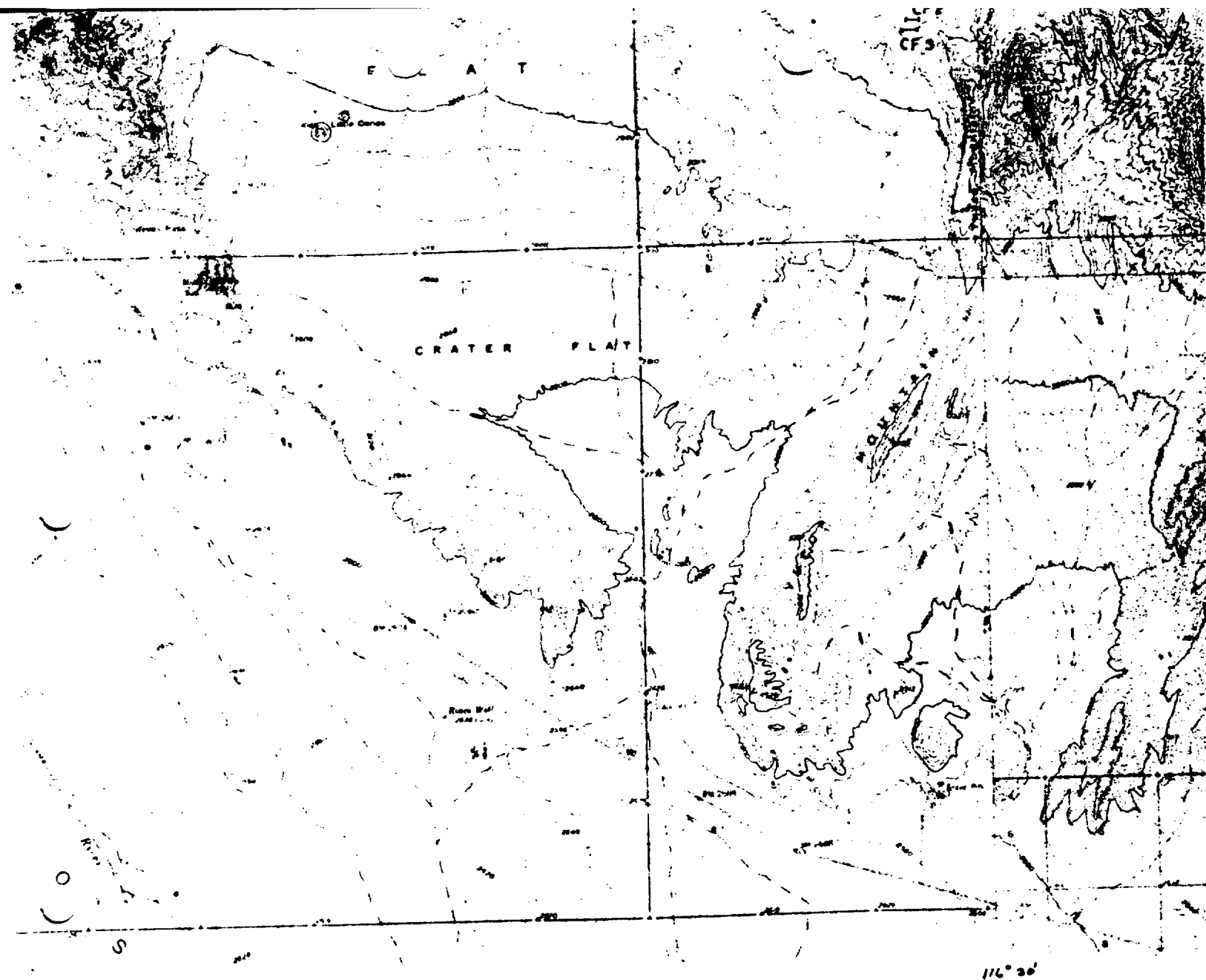
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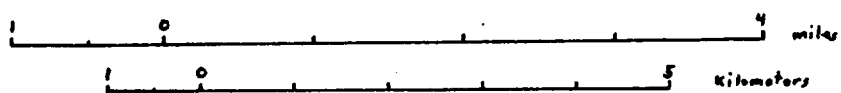
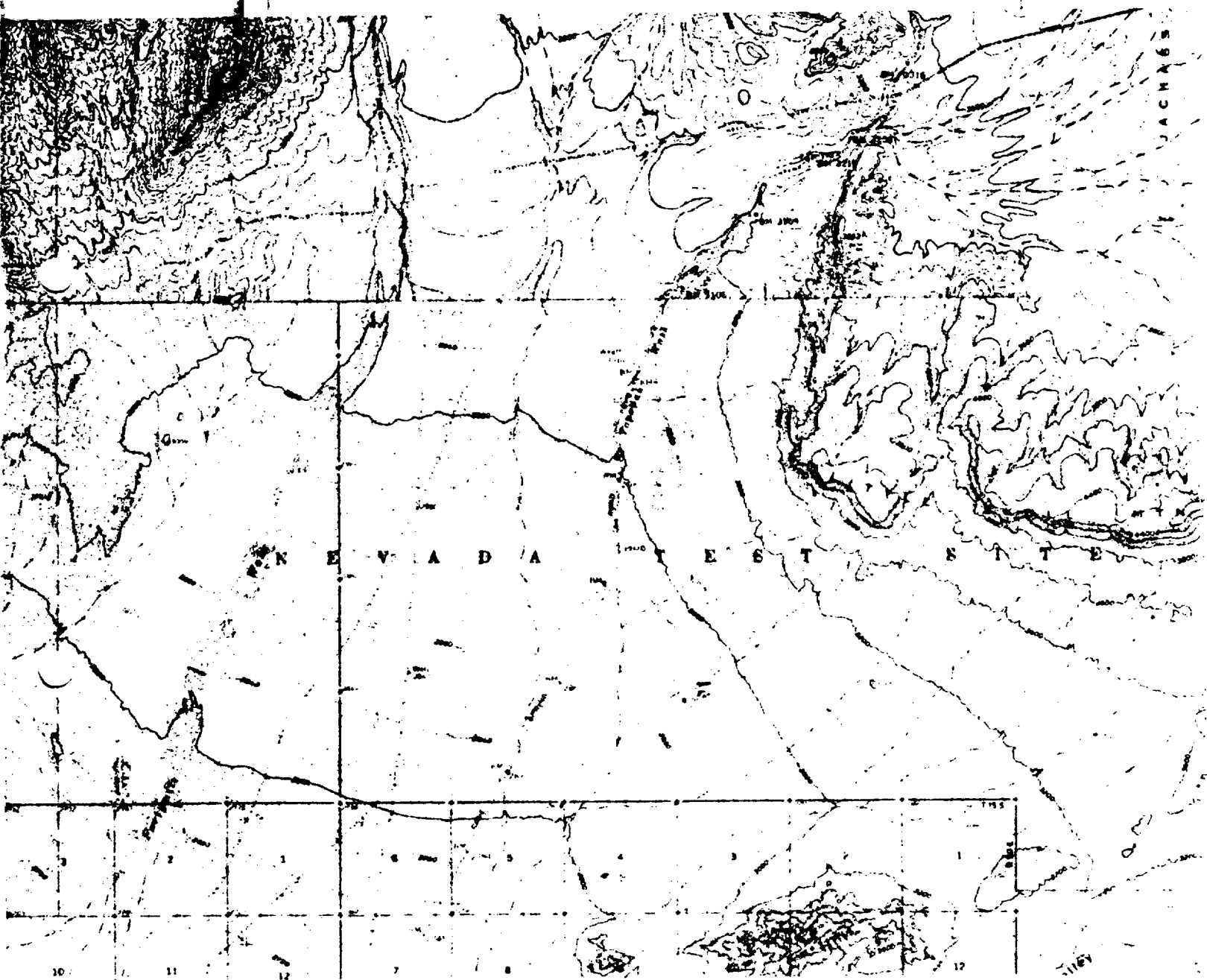
