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TRIP REPORT

At NRC's request, K. Wahi traveled to Silver Spring. Maryland, to participate in a "Document Review Meeting" as one of the SNLA representatives. The meeting was held on April 17 and 18. 1984 at the NRC Willste Building.

The primary purpose of the meeging was to discuss the status of the various documents related to waste disposal in salt and establish priorities for reviewing the key documents. Engineer's International (EI) had prepared three lists of such documents from which a set of "key documents" was selected at this meeting. SNLA was assigned two key documents for detailed review and four documents for data review. In addition, SNLA was asked to perform calculations (modeling) to determine the effects of an exploratory shaft on a salt site. Instructions were given to the contractors to prepare a response to DOE's letter (January 11, 1984) regarding exploratory shaft construction and sealing.

On the afternoon of April 18, a meeting was held between M. Nataraja (NRC Project Manager) and K. Wahi to discuss NRC's draft write-ups on (i) the Disturbed Zone; and (ii) In-situ Testing.
